 For when they placed it on his head he be-gan to dance a-round___(Oh)

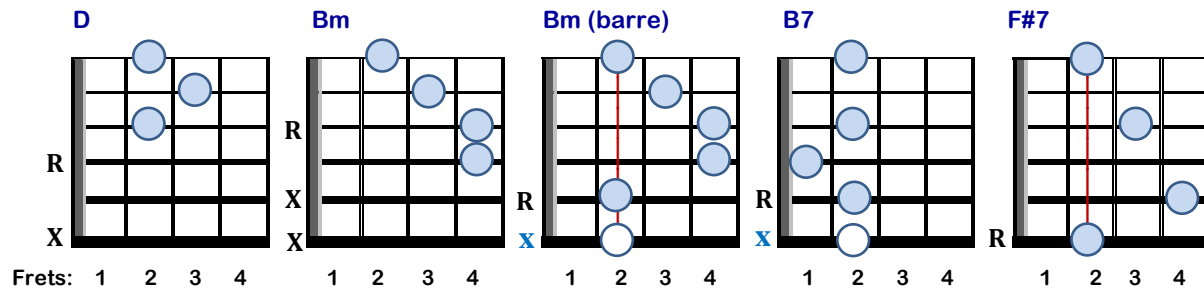
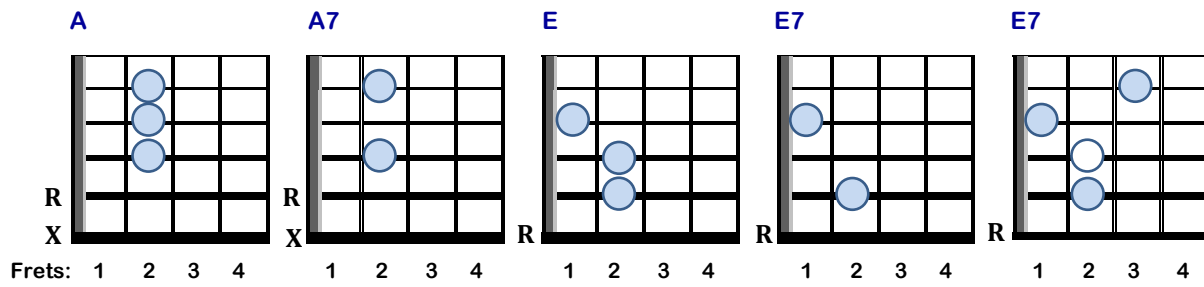
2. Fros-ty the snow-man ___ Was a-live as he could be___
